DON CAMPBELL TO RACE NASCAR STOCK CAR EVENTS IN THE COURTESY CHEVROLET MONTE CARLO

Campbell, CA (February 16, 2004) – SCCA Pro SPEED World Challenge GT driver Don Campbell will be crossing over for the first time to NASCAR stock car racing. Campbell will drive the Courtesy Chevrolet Monte Carlo in NASCAR's Late Model division at short tracks throughout California.

Professional road racer Don Campbell has decided to expand his racing background. For the past 10 years, Campbell has raced Vipers, Corvettes, Porsches, Mustangs and Camaros at road race tracks throughout the U.S. and Canada. This year will mark Campbell's first ever debut into NASCAR stock car racing.

"I would like to thank all of the people at Courtesy Chevrolet for this opportunity," said driver Don Campbell. "I am really excited to apply my 10 years of road racing experience to NASCAR oval track racing. I am sure there will be a steep learning curve but I welcome the challenge. I am confident in my driving ability, that in time, I will be competitive and hopefully run up front and win races. I have a wonderful team backing me up."

Don Campbell (Campbell, CA) has built an impressive racing resume over the last 10 years. Campbell has won numerous championships from autocrossing to road racing. Most recently, in 2003, Campbell competed in the SCCA Pro Speed World Challenge, racing his Corvette C5R throughout the U.S. and Canada. Campbell's races regularly appeared on the Speed Channel television network. He also kept busy with driver appearances and autograph sessions. Also, in 2003 Campbell raced in the longest road race in the world, The 25 Hours of Thunderhill. In 2002, Campbell won NASA's CMC Season Championship. Campbell set six road race track records at Buttonwillow, Thunderhill, Willow Springs, California Speedway, Spring Mountain and Infineon Raceway. Campbell's championship season included 10 wins and 14 pole positions. In 2001, Campbell was on the first place team at the U.S. National Viper Championships. Campbell won SCCA Solo II Regional championships in 1998, 1999 and 2000.
