DON CAMPBELL FINISHES VERY SUCCESSFUL FIRST YEAR IN NASCAR-TYPE LATE MODEL RACING

Campbell, CA (October 7, 2004) – NASCAR-type Late Model stock car driver Don Campbell completed his first season racing at Altamont Motorsports Park in Tracy, CA. Campbell finished the season with one win, one trophy dash win, 4 top-fives, and 15 top-tens out of 21 starts. Campbell finished 7th overall in season points. Professional road racer Don Campbell decided to expand his racing background. Campbell had no circle track experience prior to this year. Campbell and his team ran competitively all season, consistently qualifying and running up front.

“I am extremely pleased to have completed a very successful debut into NASCAR type stock car racing,” said driver Don Campbell. “Crossing over from road racing to circle track racing for the first time ever was very challenging. Thanks to my entire team for all of their hard work. I thought I had a chance to be competitive in this league. Don Campbell (Campbell, CA) has built an impressive racing resume over the last 10 years. Campbell has won numerous championships from autocrossing to road racing in Vipers, Corvettes, Porsches, and Camaros. Most recently, in 2003, Campbell competed in the SCCA Pro Speed World Challenge, racing his Corvette C5R throughout the U.S. and Canada. Campbell's races regularly appeared on the Speed Channel television network.

Also, in 2003 Campbell raced in the longest road race in the world, The 25 Hours of Thunderhill. In 2002, Campbell won NASA's CMC Season Championship. Campbell set six road race track records at Buttonwillow, Thunderhill, Willow Springs, California Speedway, Spring Mountain and Infineon Raceway. Campbell's championship season included 10 wins and 14 pole positions. In 2001, Campbell was on the first place team at the U.S. National Viper Championships. Campbell won SCCA Solo II Regional Championships in 1998, 1999 and 2000.
