DON CAMPBELL TO RACE IN THE NASCAR SOUTHWEST SERIES

Campbell, CA (January 7, 2005) – Late Model driver Don Campbell will be moving up the NASCAR ladder to run a full season in the AutoZone Southwest Series. Campbell will compete at tracks in California, Arizona and Colorado.

“I am looking forward to moving up the NASCAR ladder to race in the Southwest Series,” said driver Don Campbell. “I am ready to build upon the experience I gained by running 21 Late Model races last year. I will be trying to win the Rookie of the Year award and be competitive in every race. My team and I will be ready to go later this month at Phoenix International Raceway.”

Don Campbell (Campbell, CA) has built an impressive racing resume over the last 10 years. Campbell has won numerous championships from autocrossing to road racing.

In 2004, Campbell had 21 starts racing Late Models at Altamont Raceway finishing with 1 win, 1 trophy dash win, 4 top-fives, 16 top-tens and was runner-up Rookie of the Year. In 2003, Campbell competed in the SCCA Pro Speed World Challenge, racing his Corvette C5R throughout the U.S. and Canada. Campbell's races regularly appeared on the Speed Channel television network. In 2002, Campbell won NASA's CMC Season Championship. Campbell set six road race track records at Buttonwillow, Thunderhill, Willow Springs, California Speedway, Spring Mountain and Infineon Raceway. In 2001, Campbell was on the first place team at the U.S. National Viper Championships. Campbell won SCCA Solo II Regional championships in 1998, 1999 and 2000.
