DON CAMPBELL TAKES LEAD IN ROOKIE OF THE YEAR STANDINGS

Campbell, CA (May 15, 2005) – Driver Don Campbell moved into first place in the NASCAR Southwest Series Rookie of the Year standings. Campbell has been very consistent by finishing strong in every race during the first part of the season. Campbell leads Ryan Foster, Dustin Jones, David Mayhew and Stephan Sadler in the Rookie points chase.

“I am very happy to be leading the Sunoco Rookie of the Year standings,” said driver Don Campbell. “The GKI Construction Chevy has been running great. It is still early in the year but if my crew keeps giving me a great car, I like my chances of winning the award.”

Don Campbell (Campbell, CA) has built an impressive racing resume over the last 10 years. Campbell has won numerous championships from autocrossing to road racing.

In 2004, Campbell had 21 starts racing Late Models at Altamont Raceway finishing with 1 win, 1 trophy dash win, 4 top-fives, 16 top-tens and was runner-up Rookie of the Year. In 2003, Campbell competed in the SCCA Pro Speed World Challenge, racing his Corvette C5R throughout the U.S. and Canada. Campbell's races regularly appeared on the Speed Channel television network. In 2002, Campbell won NASA's CMC Season Championship. Campbell set six road race track records at Buttonwillow, Thunderhill, Willow Springs, California Speedway, Spring Mountain and Infineon Raceway. In 2001, Campbell was on the first place team at the U.S. National Viper Championships. Campbell won SCCA Solo II Regional championships in 1998, 1999 and 2000.
