Don Campbell (Campbell, CA) has built an impressive racing resume over the last 10 years. Campbell has won numerous championships from autocrossing to road racing.

In 2004, Campbell had 21 starts racing Late Models at Altamont Raceway finishing with 1 win, 1 trophy dash win, 4 top-fives, 16 top-tens and was runner-up Rookie of the Year. In 2003, Campbell competed in the SCCA Pro Speed World Challenge, racing his Corvette C5R throughout the U.S. and Canada. Campbell's races regularly appeared on the Speed Channel television network. In 2002, Campbell won NASA's CMC Season Championship. Campbell set six road race track records at Buttonwillow, Thunderhill, Willow Springs, California Speedway, Spring Mountain and Infineon Raceway. In 2001, Campbell was on the first place team at the U.S. National Viper Championships. Campbell won SCCA Solo II Regional championships in 1998, 1999 and 2000.
