Campbell, CA (March 31, 2002) – A new track record was set last weekend by Don Campbell at California Speedway in Fontana, CA. Campbell drove his Speed Merchant Chevy Camaro to a blistering fast lap to establish a new NASA CMC road race series track record. Campbell had a perfect dream weekend. Campbell also captured the pole position for both races on his way to winning both races.
