**DON CAMPBELL WINS NASA'S CMC SEASON CHAMPIONSHIP
DRIVING THE SPEED MERCHANT CHEVY CAMARO**

Campbell, CA (December 1, 2002) – Don Campbell just completed the most dominating season in the history of NASA's CMC road racing series. Campbell ended up shattering 5 track records, had 10 wins and a record setting 14 pole positions.

"I am living a dream right now," said the humbled driver Don Campbell. "I just wanted to be competitive and consistent this season. The series is an American Muscle road race duel between the Chevy Camaro and the Ford Mustang. The Camaro-Mustang Challenge (CMC) has a strict set of rules so that all of the cars are prepared virtually the same.

Don Campbell (Campbell, CA) set the five NASA CMC track records at Thunderhill Park, California Speedway, Buttonwillow Raceway, Willow Springs and Infineon Raceway. The record setting 14 pole positions will be a very difficult record for someone to break.
