**DON CAMPBELL LEADS SEASON POINTS BATTLE AND SETS
INFINEON RACEWAY TRACK RECORD**

Campbell, CA (July 15, 2002) – NASA’s Camaro-Mustang Challenge driver Don Campbell is currently leading the series points battle. Campbell has scored 6 pole positions, 5 wins and 9 podium finishes so far this year. Campbell is having an unbelievable season setting three more track records at Buttonwillow Raceway, Thunderhill Park and Infineon Raceway in Sonoma, California. These track records are in addition to the one Campbell set earlier in the year at California Speedway in Fontana.

“This Speed Merchant Chevy Corvette has performed flawlessly this season,” said driver Don Campbell. My goal for this year was to be competitive and run up front. I had no idea I would set 4 track records, have a bunch of wins and be leading the season points battle. There is still a lot of racing left in this season but I like my chances of finishing the season strong.”

The series is an American Muscle duel between the Chevy Camaro and the Ford Mustang. The Camaro-Mustang Challenge (CMC) has a strict set of rules so that all of the cars are prepared virtually the same. On any given race day, any car has a potentially equal chance to win. This type of series emphasizes the talent of the driver rather than the size of the team budget.
